Our Mission

To improve health outcomes for Latinos in New York City who are affected by HIV and other chronic illnesses. Established in 1985, the Hispanic AIDS Forum (HAF) is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization. HAF provides support and services to New York City Latinos affected by HIV, Sexually Transmitted Infections, Hepatitis, Tuberculosis, and Diabetes.

Our Services

From 7/1/07 to 6/30/08, HAF provided services to **6,070** unduplicated participants, **725** of whom are enrolled as clients (see table).

Participants received **85,107** units of service:

- 8,658** Case Management;
 - 1,859** Supportive Counseling;
 - 5,345** HIV Tests;
 - 15,806** HIV Prevention Counseling;
 - 17,439** Community Education;
 - 36,000** Safer Sex Kits;
- and over **\$1.733Million** in financial assistance to low income households affected by HIV.

Our Clients

Our clients represent the full diversity of our target communities. They include heterosexual, bisexual and homosexual men, women, transgender and youth of numerous ethnic and national origins. Moreover, our clients are not only Latino; they also include Whites, African Americans and other People of Color. Finally, our clients come from all sorts of everyday living conditions defined by their socioeconomic status, education level and the level of risk for HIV they encounter. This wide range of individuals approach HAF because they know that our doors are open to them. They also trust our ability to effectively and sensitively address their needs.
